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Chapter 8: What are the Ethical and Legal Issues Facing Teachers?

Standards/goals (What do you want us to know?)

- · the difference between ethics and the law
- · characteristics of ethical teaching
- teacher's rights & responsibilities
- student's rights & responsibilities

Anticipatory set (What are you going to do to get us interested?)

- Ethics song (You Tube video)

Step by step procedures (Be sure to incorporate teaching strategies: cooperative learning, multiple intelligences, literature, videos, discussions (higher order thinking), activities.... extend the chapter and make it applicable/interesting)

- power point
 - · ethics song
 - definitions (linguistic intelligences)
 - characteristics of ethical teaching (headings)

Closing activity (can be a wrap-up activity or discussion, assessment, game, etc.)

- Break into groups of 3 or 4 so there are 6 groups total
- Each group will have a handout of some kind of legal/ethical issue. There will be doubles.
- Give students *time* to read and discuss. Tell them to apply the characteristics of ethical teaching to their case. (have powerpoint ready)
